Preston: Percy "Buck" Bertollette Lewis, 86, of Preston, died on Tuesday, October 4, 2011 at William Hill Manor in Easton. Born in Easton on August 19, 1925, he was the son of the late Percy Marr Lewis and Catherine Taylor Lewis.

Mr. Lewis was a Talbot county dairy farmer. In 1966 the family moved to Preston, MD and purchased a poultry farm. In addition to farming, Mr. Lewis was employed at Grayblock, formerly Delmarva Industries, as well as Waverly Press retiring in 1991.

He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Easton, and a former member of the Talbot County Farm Bureau and the Easton Odd Fellows.

Mr. Lewis is survived by his wife of 60 years, Nellie Elizabeth Sherwood Lewis, whom he married in 1951. In addition to his wife, he is survived by five sons: Jack B. Lewis and wife Teresa, Dale S. Lewis and wife Lee, Laird L. Lewis and wife Carolyn, Tyler B. Lewis and wife Denise and Bryant K. Lewis; a sister Rebecca Dean of Quincy, MA. He was preceded in death by a son, William Perry Lewis who died in 1989.
