Percy Elwood Allen, of Wye Mills, died at The Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton, on Thursday, April 25, 2002. He was 88.

Born July 24, 1913 in Wye Mills, he was one of 14 children of the late Bennett C. and Mary Elsie Harrington Allen. After attending public school, he worked in his family's general store and cement block manufacturing business. During World War II, he worked in the Cambridge Shipyard. Following the war, he began his career in carpentry, working the majority of the time for the Phillips Lumber Co. in Sudlersville and then retiring in 1975 from the George C. Rada Company in Grasonville.

A lifelong resident of Wye Mills, he was a member of the Wye Mills United Methodist church.

His wife, the former Helen Frances Mac Lean whom he married on Jan. 6, 1936, died Jan. 15, 1992.

Mr. Allen is survived by a daughter, Martha Thomas of Dundalk; a son, Stephen B. Allen of Wye Mills; three sisters, Louise A. Lee and Ethel A. Uber, both of Wye Mills and Greta A. Towers of Denton; two brothers, Herbert H. Allen of Grasonville and Thomas K. Allen of Wye Mills; three grandchildren, Kathleen Cramer, William D. McGuire and Vincent T. Allen and six great-

grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, April 29th at 2 P.M. at the Wye Mills United Methodist Church, Wye Mills, where friends may call one hour prior to service.

Burial will be at Old Wye Cemetery, Wye Mills.
