



## Perry Hammond Dyott Jr.

October 29, 1927 - April 13, 2013

Perry Hammond Dyott, Jr., of Wittman, MD, passed away on Saturday, April 13, 2013, at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. He was 85.

Born in Easton on October 29, 1927, he was the son of Perry Hammond Dyott, Sr., and Effie Jones Dyott.

He attended Easton High School and later enlisted in the Navy.

After his honorable discharge from the Navy, he moved to Wittman to live with his parents. On March 14, 1959, he married the former Helen Dolores Lindsay who was also from Wittman. He and Mrs. Dyott moved to Florida shortly after their marriage and, upon return to Talbot County, Perry became a commercial waterman, a profession he kept for life. Mrs. Dyott passed away in 1987. After her death, Perry remained a life-long resident of Wittman.

Perry had many hobbies. He was an avid hunter, fisherman, and long-time softball player, playing in many leagues throughout his life. His life was devoted to his family and, in particular, his grandchildren, Abbie and Alex. There has never been a greater grandfather than Perry. He spent many hours enjoying his grandchildren and attending their many activities. He also enjoyed his many friends and visited them often. He is remembered by some of his friends as "the unofficial Mayor of Wittman."

Perry is survived by his daughter, Monica Heinsohn and her husband, Jeff, of Cordova; two grandchildren, Abigail and Alexander Heinsohn; his sisters, Dorothy Plugge and June Tribett, both of Easton; his aunts, Hazel Seville of Waynesboro, PA, Thelma Starkey of Catonsville, and Mary Pinder of Denton; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Memorial services will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home in Easton on Saturday, April 20, 2013, at 11 a.m. The Reverend Nevin Crouse will officiate.

Burial for Perry and Helen will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park immediately following the service.
