Peter Albert Srsic passed away unexpectedly from natural causes at his place of residence in Chester, Maryland. He was 65 years old.

Peter Albert Srsic was born in Baltimore, Maryland at Johns Hopkins Hospital on February 18th, 1960 . He was raised in Severna Park and later resided in Queenstown, Maryland. He attended Martin Spalding High School in Severn, Maryland. Then, after his high school graduation he attended Loyola College in Baltimore, Maryland, where he studied psychology. He graduated from Loyola College on May 30, 1982. He went on to earn his master's in psychology from Catholic University in Washington D.C.

Peter held several jobs in his lifetime. He worked for the Ty Beanie Baby Company at the height of their popularity. Then, for years he was the manager of Miss Betty's Hallmark Store on Kent Island. He loved talking to the customers and helping them choose the perfect gift or card. Peter loved to talk to people and many remember him working at Miss Betty's Hallmark. It was in this position where he learned how to engrave glasses and trophies. After the store closed, he opened his own business engraving locally. He engraved trophies for Little League, yacht clubs, country clubs, oceanside souvenir shops and personal gifts. People would always remark how lovely his engraving projects turned out. He had a talent for engraving and was very proud of the work that he did.

Peter also loved sports. He was a huge Ravens and Orioles fan. He would attend all the Ravens home games along with tailgating with his best buddies. He would never miss the opening day of the Orioles. Peter loved going to Saratoga to watch the horse races and he attended many Preakness races in Baltimore, Maryland. He loved watching game shows, such as Jeopardy being his favorite. He had quite a memory of trivia and loved to attend trivia nights at the local restaurants.

Peter was very devoted to his family and friends. He had such a good heart and would do anything for anyone. This was evident when he helped care for his father with ALS and then his elderly mother. Peter loved being with his Loyola college friends. They were his extended family. Peter will fondly be remembered for his sweetness, kindness and his loyalty to his family and friends. He will be very much missed.

Peter is survived by his siblings and family, Karen Srsic, Elizabeth Conolly, her husband Peter Conolly and Rebecca Mobley. 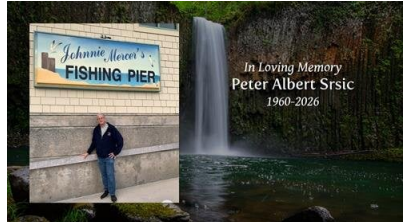

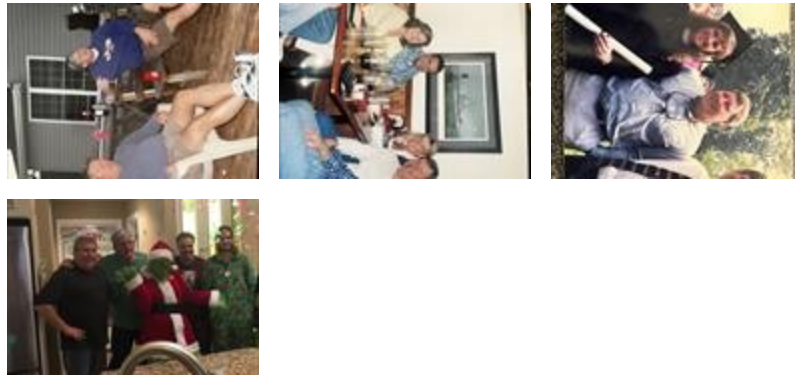
