Peter C. Philip, of Royal Oak, MD went to be with the Lord on Saturday morning, January 14, 2006, at the Virginia Hospital Center, Alexandria, Va. He was 66.

Born May 16, 1939 in Montclair, NJ, he was the son of the late Abram C. and Rose Molyneux Philip. After graduating from Barnegat High School in Barnegat, NJ, he served in the U S. Navy for four years. In 1976, he and his wife moved to Easton, MD where they opened the Peppermint Stick Ice Cream Parlor in the Tred Avon Shopping Center. In 1979, they bought the Avon Decorating Center business in which they worked and grew for the next 22 years, before retiring in 2001.

A loving and caring person, he poured his heart out for orphaned children in India. He was an original board member of the Children's Fellowship of India, an orphanage which started with 16 children in 2001 and now, with his help, has over 100 children today.

He had also taken mission trips to Alaska for Stonecroft Ministry and was a former member of the Board of Campus life.

Mr. Philip was a charter member, former Trustee, Deacon and Sunday school teacher of the Talbot Bible Church in Easton, a church that he had helped build. He enjoyed sailing and skiing and helping others in his leisure time.

Surviving are his wife, the former Joyce A. Rankin whom he married Oct. 19, 1963; a daughter, Pamela Wheat and her husband, Jonathan of Dillsburg, PA; two sons, Timothy Philip and his wife, Cheri, of Royal Oak and Ben Philip and his fiancée, Julie Wernick, of Easton; a sister, Ann Anderson, of Milltown, IN; four grandchildren, Rebekah Wheat, Peter Wheat, Noah Philip and Brody Philip; and a “grand dog”, Dutch.

Memorial services will be held at the Talbot Bible Church, Easton, on Wednesday, January 18th at 7 p.m. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the memorial service.
