



## Peter Gabriel Catucci

March 7, 1949 - April 3, 2009

Peter G. Catucci, long-time champion of organized labor, passed away on Friday, April 3, 2009, in his Davidsonville, Maryland home after a lengthy battle with ALS. He was 60 years old.

Born on March 7, 1949, in Washington, D.C., he was the third of Pietro and Juanita Catucci's eleven children. Pete devoted his life's work to advancing labor rights. Before retiring in 2008, he was Communications Workers of America (CWA) District Two Vice President for 23 years.

His wife, Terry, survives him, as do his children Nick (Mary), Traci (John Paul), and Francesca (Josh), five grandchildren, nine of his siblings, a host of doting nieces and nephews, and a grieving cat. Pete and Terry, high school sweethearts, would have celebrated their 40th anniversary on May 3rd of this year.

Since being diagnosed with ALS in February 2007, Pete tirelessly campaigned to remove restrictions on federal funding for embryonic stem-cell research. When President Obama signed an executive order to that end in a White House ceremony on March 9, 2009, Pete and Terry were among the President's guests.

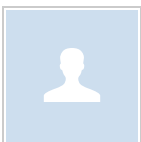

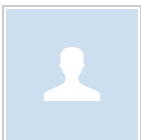

I left C & P several months after my grievance was denied to begin my dual careers in financial services and transportation. My days as an activist are a distant memory, but I am proud to have been a member of Local 2336.

It also should be noted here that I have NEVER crossed a picket line nor do I ever intend to do so.

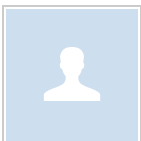
