Phebe Ann Baum, of Oxford, a retired merchant and real estate salesperson, died at The Memorial Hospital At Easton on Saturday, October 13, 2001. She was 79.

Born in Chester County, PA, January 8, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Francis and Phebe Price Jacobs. After graduating from the Westown Friends School in Westown, PA in 1935 and the Warrenton Girls School in Warrenton, VA in 1939, she married Charles M. Cann. This marriage ended in divorce. Later, while living in Bermuda, she met and married Harry B. Smith who died in 1950. On August 8, 1953, she married Chester Earle Baum, Jr., a teacher at St. Andrews School in Middletown, DE.

They lived at Middletown until moving to Oxford in 1969 where she owned and operated the Burgee Shop from 1969 until its close in 1973. She later worked as a real estate salesperson for LaMotte Properties until retiring in 1987 when they moved to Punta Gorda, FL. They returned to Oxford in 1995.

An accomplished sailor in Lightning Class Sailboats, she was a guest member of the Royal Hellenic Yacht Club in Athens, Greece, where she won the 1964 King's Cup and was awarded the trophy by King Constantine, himself. She was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford where she was the winner of the Master's Race in 1986. She had held membership in the Bermuda Anglers Club in the 1940's and was a member of the Bermuda

National Fishing Team.

Surviving, in addition to her husband, are five sons, Charles M. Cann of Marion, MA, Daniel B. Smith and William B. Smith, both of Oxford, Henry B. Smith of Hamilton, Bermuda and Price A. Baum of Oxford and five grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, October 20th, at 11 A. M. at the Church of The Holy Trinity, Oxford. Inurnment will be in the Holy Trinity Columbarium.
