May 24, 1961 - March 25, 2026

The world lost a bright light when Philip Joseph Maloney of Greenwood, DE, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at Bayhealth Hospital, Sussex Campus, following a short yet courageous battle with cancer. He was 64.

Born on May 24, 1961 in Wilmington, DE, Phil was the son of Lester H. Maloney, Jr. and Lucy Crabtree.

A 1979 graduate of North Harford High School, Phil embodied a strong work ethic and an unwavering commitment to providing for his family.
