Philip Mastandrea, Sr. went home to meet the Lord on Saturday, December 29, 2007, at the University of Maryland Medical Center, Baltimore. He was 82.

Born on October 6, 1925 in Brooklyn, New York, he was the son of the late John Mastrandrea and Arcangela Molfetta Mastrandrea. He was a graduate of Bay Shore High School, New York. He served his country as a Naval Air Pilot during World War II and attended Brooklyn College and Brown University as a Chemistry Major. After completing his college education, he worked for the Brooklyn Eagle and the Journal of Commerce as an advertising sales executive.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son Philip Mastandrea, Jr. He shared his faith in Jesus Christ with his family and friends. He was a devoted husband and father, and truly loved the Lord.

On February 6, 1949, he married the former Grace Colucci (Mastandrea.) They lived on Long Island, New York until 1992 when they moved to Trappe, Maryland.
