



Philip Roman Ortt

March 2, 1931 - June 20, 2018

Philip Roman Ortt died on June 20, 2018, surrounded by his four daughters at Bayleigh Chase Community in Easton MD. He was 87 years old.

As a lifelong member of Talbot County, he loved hunting, boating, and crabbing. He enjoyed many days on the water with his father, brothers, sister, wife, and daughters.

He was born on March 2, 1931, to the late Roman H. Ortt and Kathryn B. Collier. His boyhood was spent in St. Michaels. He graduated from St. Michaels High School and attended St. Johns College in Annapolis, MD. On September 1, 1951, Phil married Emily Lee Sewell, and they made their home in Easton, MD. He worked as a diesel mechanic for Elliott Wilson Trucks and retired at the age of 63.

Mr. Ortt was a lifelong parishioner of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church. He was an active member of Knights of Columbus Council No. 2274 and Father Mosley Assembly No. 1929 for which he was Past Grand Knight. He was often seen over the years at "Bingo" as a worker and always part of their fundraisers.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Emily, in 2014.

Phil is survived by his four daughters, Stephanie (Tom), Phylis (Dallas), Theresa and Christine; his siblings, James (Barbara), Richard (Dorothy) and Barbara (William); grandchildren, Damien Sisca, Nicholas Sisca, Vincent (Theresa) Sisca, Kyle (Manoshi) Stoker, Todd (Ashley) Stoker, Dustin (Becky) Pope, Hayley Pope, Carley Porter, and Hannah Porter; great-grandchildren, Maya, Roman, Isaiah, Abram, Titus, Everett, Wyatt and soon to be born Seth; and his many nieces and nephews.

A funeral liturgy will be celebrated at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 1210 S. Washington St., in Easton on Friday, June 29, 2018, at 11:00 AM, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
