Philip E. Andrew, Sr. of Musella, GA died on Tuesday, December 30, 2003. He was 85.

Born October 29, 1918 in Talbot County, he was the son of the late Lloyd B. and Gladys Emerson Andrew. He attended public school in Talbot and Queen Anne Counties. During World War II he served in the United States Army as a combat engineer in the Philippines. After his release from active duty he returned to the Eastern Shore and worked at the Locker Plant in Centreville. He then worked for R.B. Baker & Sons for 44 years until his retirement.

His wife, the former Kathryn Elaine Hunter died November 27, 1994.

He was a life member, a charter member and 1st Commander of Benedict A. Andrew American Legion Post 296 in Queenstown, and a life member of V.F.W. Post 7464 in Grasonville.

Mr. Andrew is survived by a son, Philip E. Andrew, Jr. and his wife Patsy of Musella, GA; a sister, Agnes Stem of Timonium, MD; a brother R.E. Lee Andrew of Smyrna, DE; and one grandson, Eric B. Andrew of Savannah, GA. He was predeceased by four brothers and one sister.
