Philip Thomas Davidson, Sr. of Stevensville, died on Wednesday, May 15, 2002.

He was born July 25, 1899, the first son of Mary Madaline Mitchell Davidson and Philip Thomas Davidson of Irishtown, now known as Pintail Point. His childhood was spent there and in the Queenstown area.

He was educated at the Donaldson School in Tolchester.

He worked as a farmer and a landscaper all of his life.

In the early 1920's, Mr. Davidson moved from Greenwood Creek to the Thompson Farm, now known as Kent Manor Inn, on Kent Island. He married Pauline Jackson in 1923. They first lived at the Greenwood Creek Farm, then moved to the Carville Farm, in Stevensville, where he lived until the end of his life.

Mr. Davidson is survived by four sons, John Fountain Davidson, Harry Mitchell Davidson, Philip Jackson Davidson and Philip Thomas Davidson; two daughters, Louise Davidson Price and Phyllis Davidson Pippin. He leaves twenty-nine grandchildren, thirty-nine great-grandchildren and five great-great grandchildren. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Marcella Mitchell Swain, and

three brothers, Colins Wright Davidson, George Earle Davidson and C. B. Mitchell Davidson.

Having lived during three centuries, Mr. Davidson was a wise and much loved husband, father and grandfather.
