



## Phillip Carmello Marsiglia

December 14, 1921 - December 2, 2015

Phillip Carmello Marsiglia died on December 2, 2015, at Compass Regional Hospice. He was 93.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on Dec. 14, 1921, he was the son of the late Salvatore and Mary Zanti Marsiglia. He grew up in Baltimore, MD, and attended St. John's School. Phillip began his career at an early age working in his family's produce business. He served in the Army Air Corps during World War II, successfully flying 39 missions over Europe, before his honorable discharge. After returning to Baltimore, Phillip married the late Betty Jane Pettit. That marriage later ended.

Phillip greatly expanded the family business into the regional wholesale produce company, P&M Produce. In 1974 Phillip married Shirley Oler. In 1975, Phillip and Shirley moved to Stevensville, MD, where he was able to enjoy the Eastern Shore lifestyle by boating and fishing on the Chesapeake Bay. He also enjoyed woodworking, traveling, and an occasional game of poker.

He is survived by his loving wife of 41 years, Shirley Oler Marsiglia; his children: Phillip L. Marsiglia (Diane) of Phoenix, MD, Richard M. Marsiglia of Baltimore, MD, Phyllis A. Strassner (David) of Baltimore, MD, Sherry Lurie (Theodore -partner) of Centreville, MD and Corinne Bowen (David) of

Baltimore; 12 grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; a nephew, Vincent Liberto (Nancy) of Severna Park; a god-daughter and several loving nieces and friends. He was preceded in death by his sister, Rosie Liberto; and brother, John Marsiglia.
