



## Phillip Alfred Young

Phillip Alfred "Skip" Young of Easton, MD passed away, after a long courageous battle with cancer, on Sunday, November 20, 2005 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 73.

Born October 31, 1932 in Dixonville, PA, he was the son of the late Benjamin Alfred and Mary Bailey Young. As a young boy he worked with his dad in the coal mines and later went into the logging business in Pennsylvania. After moving to Maryland, he worked for Kenneth D. Brown & Son Excavating.
