June 28, 1954 - September 26, 2008

Phillip Daniel Dupy of Stevensville, MD died Friday September 26, 2008 at his home after a long illness. He was 54.

Born on June 28, 1954 in Winfield, Kansas he is the son of Bonita A. Thornhill Dupy and the late John Milton Dupy. Phil grew up in Midwest City, OK and was a graduate of Star Spencer High School. He would later graduate from Business College in Oklahoma receiving an associates degree. He began his career in newspaper circulation and operations with the Daily Oklahoman until the Washington Post recruited him as circulation zone manager in the Rockville and Potomac area. Phil would leave the Post and move to Missouri where he continued to work as an operations manager and consultant with American Publishing with various newspapers in the Ozark, Missouri area. His last job before becoming ill and retiring due to disability was with Gannett in Jackson, Miss. He would later move to Kent Island, MD to be near his family. He enjoyed all the recreation that Chesapeake Bay living brings such as, crabbing, fishing, hunting camping, gardening and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his beloved wife Rosemarie Patane Dupy of Stevensville, MD; his mother Bonita A. Dupy of Mt. Vernon, TX; ex-wife Bonnie Dupy; four sons Christopher R. Dupy of Gaithersburg, MD ; Phillip J. Dupy of Gaithersburg, MD; Joshua M. Dupy of Germantown, MD and Zachariah W.

Dupy of Frederick, MD. a step daughter Marie Allegar Edwards; a sisters Sharon Selvy and her husband Don of Serra Vista, AZ; and Bonnie Jo Sturgeon and her husband Joe of Mt. Pleasant, TX and a brother James H. Dupy and his wife Joy of Edmond, OK; three grandchildren Chandler; Jonathon and Sebastian.

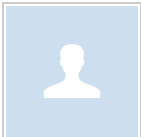

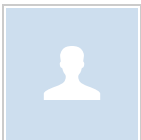
