Phillip W. "Yarney" Crockett died at the Genesis Elder Care, The Pines, Easton, MD on Monday, March 13, 2006. He was 67.

Born on April 11, 1938 in Crisfield, MD, he was the son of the late Burton and Mabel Betts Crockett. In 1957, while attending Crisfield High School, he played basketball where his team won first State Championship. Immediately after graduation, in 1957, he enlisted in the United States Air Force where he received the rank of Airman First Class before being honorably discharged in 1961.

Following his release from active duty, Mr. Crockett returned home and he began working on the water, crabbing. Later in 1961 he moved to Brooklyn Park, MD to begin working for Baltimore Cold Storage. In 1963 he began working for Westinghouse. It was in 1963 when Mr. Crockett began his career as Building Manager working for I.I.T. Research where he remained until his retirement in 2000.

On May 11, 1963 he married Brenda J. Harrison of Baltimore, MD and they made their first home in Brooklyn Park, MD where they resided for 13 years and before they moved to the Eastern Shore where they resided in Kent Island for 12 years and Centreville for 10 years. He moved to Easton, MD in 2000 after his retirement.

Mr. Crockett enjoyed horseracing, bowling, crabbing with his sons and the outdoors.

In addition to his wife, Brenda, he is survived by two sons, Timothy "Tim" Crockett of Baltimore, MD and Bobby Crockett of Chestertown, MD; one daughter, Jenny Gardner of Centreville, MD; four grandchildren, Jeffrey Gardner of Centreville, MD, Josh Gardner of Centreville, MD, Abby Jane Crockett of Chestertown, MD and Max Crockett of Baltimore, MD.

Funeral services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Centreville, MD on Friday, March 17, 2006 at 1:00 PM where friends may call from 12-1 PM.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
