



Phyllis S. Callahan

August 20, 1936 - April 7, 2018

Phyllis S. Callahan died April 7th, 2018, at her home, "The Reynolds Farm," in Cordova. She was 81.

Born August 20, 1936, at Easton, she was the oldest of eight children, daughter to the late Paul and Margaret (Callahan) Shortall.

Phyllis graduated from Easton High School in 1954. She married Robert H. Callahan, Sr., on November 12, 1955. Together they farmed the "Reynolds Farm" until Mr. Callahan died on December 31, 1996. Phyllis was a member of Old St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Cordova, where she was also a member of the choir. She was also a member of the Prayer Shawl Ministry of Sts. Peter and Paul Parish. She enjoyed crocheting for her family and friends, and her weekly card games with friends.

Phyllis is survived by her three children, Margaret Roe (Dale), Bobby Callahan, and Howard Callahan (Carla); her siblings, Nancy Gambrill, Paul Lee Shortall, Jr., Jeannette Campbell, Irene Simpson, Richard Shortall, Theresa Snitker, and Raymond Shortall; six grandsons; and 14 great-grandchildren. She was loved by many as mom-mom, grandma, and granny. Phyllis was preceded by a grandson Christopher who died in March of 1984.
