September 3, 1927 - June 20, 2016

Phyllis Lowery Davidson Pippin of Stevensville, MD, died of complications of pneumonia on June 20, 2016, at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis. She was 88.

Born September 3, 1927, in Stevensville, MD, at 200 Davidson Farm Lane. She was the daughter of the late Phillip T. and Pauline Jackson Davidson and the granddaughter of the late John Fountain and Florence Lowery Jackson and Phillip T. Sr., and Madeline Mitchell Davidson.

After graduating from Western Maryland College in 1948 and Loyola College in 1971, she later retired as a teacher in 1981. In 1949, she married Thomas S. Pippin, Jr., at Old Wye Church, Wye Mills, MD. Mr. Pippin died in 1999.

Phyllis is survived by her three children, Sarah (Sally) P. Middleton, Susan F. Pippin, Sordy Pippin; beloved grandsons, Thomas Justin Middleton, Taylor Sorden Middleton; son-in-law, Ted Middleton; granddaughter in law, Anna V.
