Phyllis Callahan Spies of Henderson, MD. died Wednesday, November 14, 2018, at Compass Regional Hospice in Centreville. She was 82.

Mrs. Spies was born on April 12, 1936, in Queen Anne, MD. She was the daughter of the late P. Temple Callahan and Elsie N. Moore Callahan. She graduated from Centreville High School, Class of 1954 and continued her education at Lively Technical School in FL.

Phyllis married James R. Spies on June 26, 1954. They resided in Talbot County and later moved to Henderson in 1961. She worked on the farm while taking care of their home. She later worked for Delmarva Sash & Door Co., Barclay, MD, from 1970 until starting employment with The Hechinger Company in 1988 in Annapolis, MD, and Dover, DE, until retiring in 2001.

Phyllis was active in the Maryland & National Guernsey Association, Talbot County Homemakers Club, Tuckahoe Equestrian Center, and Mid- Atlantic Haflinger Association.

She is survived by her husband, James R. Spies, Sr.; a daughter Cindy Spies-Niehaus (the late Raymond); a son, James R. Spies, Jr. (Mary Lou); two brothers, Phillip T. Callahan (Betty) and E. Vaughn Callahan (Renee); two sisters, Frieda C. Hopkins (Dave) and Cheryl D. Salaski (Ski); three

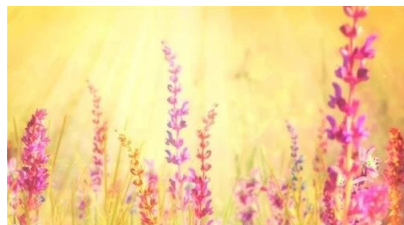

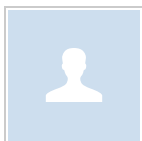
