May 30, 1941 - August 26, 2013

After a long battle with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), Polly has embarked on a new journey with her Lord. Polly passed away comfortably at the Talbot Hospice House on the morning of August 26, 2013.

Polly was the daughter of Edmund D. and Polly Cora Mulville, and she was raised in Chevy Chase, MD. She is survived by her husband, Calvin; a brother, Daniel; and a sister, Mary Patricia Viney. Polly married Calvin in 1962, and they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in February 2012. They had two children, Gwen Lacy (Michael) and Graham Yowell (Helena); and five grandchildren whom she cherished, Matthew and Megan Lacy and Jonathan, Marissa, and Daniela Yowell.

For the majority of Polly's married life she was a stay-at-home mom, and she gave freely of her time assisting elementary classroom teachers and serving in multiple capacities in her church. Since retiring to Easton in 1994, Polly was very active in the United Methodist Women at St. Mark's UMC, and she participated in the Talbot County Women's Club.
