Prentice Wayne "P.W." Hall, Jr. died on May 18, 2010. He was 42 years old.

Born in Riverdale, MD on October 21, 1967, he was the son of P. Wayne Hall, Sr. and Mary E. Hall. He graduated from North Dorchester High School in 1987 and worked for 15 years as a machinist at Black and Decker. He worked for the Solo Cup Company as a mechanic for six years, and then worked for Tieder Electric in Cambridge. Mr. Hall then attended Chesapeake College, earned his Commercial Driver's License in 2009, and began a career as a truck driver. He began training with C.R. England on April 3, 2010. He finished his training in mid-April and began driving. He enjoyed driving and seeing the western United States.

He was a member of the Sons of the American Legion Squadron 70, the Elks, most recently as a member of Lodge #2458 in Seaford, DE, the Assateague Mobile Sports Fishing Association, the Tuckahoe Steam and Gas Association, the Paw Paw Creek Hunting Club, and the Marshy Hope Rod and Gun Club.

Mr. Hall is survived by both of his parents; his pal, "Brutus" and many loving cousins, aunts and uncles.
