Presley "Buck" G. Reamy of Stevensville, MD died on Monday, July 15, 2002, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 84.

Born on Kent Island on April 2, 1918, he was the son of the late Augustus Klebo and Mary Ann Roberta Graham Reamy. He attended school in Chester, MD, and served in the U.S. Army during World War II. On April 20, 1963, he married Anita Seward of Chester. She predeceased him on June 23, 1989.

Mr. Reamy worked on the Matapeake Ferry System as an able-bodied seaman. When the William Preston Lane Memorial bridge opened, he transferred to the Maintenance Department where he worked until his retirement. He was a member of the Grasonville V.F.W. Post #7464.

Mr. Reamy is survived by three sisters, Elsie Porter of Stevensville, Elizabeth Haddaway of Grasonville, and Edna Britt of Grasonville; and a brother, Charles Reamy of Stevensville. He was predeceased by two sisters, the late Irma R. Britt, who died September 8, 1985, and the late Pearl Gardner, who died February 23, 2001; and a special nephew, the late Rodney Britt, who died September 22, 1998.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, July 18, 2002, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home in Chester at 11:00 AM. Friends may

call on Wednesday, July 17, from 6:00 to 8:00 PM at the funeral home.

Burial will be at the Stevensville Cemetery.
