Priscilla Jane "Scotty" Woods died on Sunday, May 27, 2001. She was 58.

Born in North Andover, MA, on October 15, 1942, she was the daughter of Constance Etchells McAndrew and the late William McAndrew. After graduating from high school, she received a degree from the Nasson College in Springvale, ME.

Her accomplishments include teaching history, producing theatre productions at the Friends Academy in Dartmouth, MA, becoming an award winning dressage rider, and sailing in the Atlantic. Upon moving to the Eastern Shore, she opened a yarn and knitting shop in St. Michaels. She also was active in the Historical Society and theatre groups in Easton. In January 1990, she married Jack Blanchard Woods, and they made their home in Preston and started their antique business.

Scotty was a charming lady and it was a privilege just to have known her.

In addition to her mother and husband, she is survived by a brother, William Webster McAndrew of Lexington, MA.
