



Providence Marianna McCauley

August 2, 1934 - November 11, 2008

Providence M. McCauley of Chester, MD passed away on Tuesday, November 11, 2008 at Johns Hopkins Hospital. She was 74 years old. Born in Baltimore, MD on August 2, 1934, she was the daughter of the late Thomas Maggio and Maria S. Maggio. After attending St. Paul's Business School and graduating in 1951, she worked for the State of Maryland Workmen's Compensation, Motor Vehicle Administration, and Social Security Administration until her retirement in 1986. Since 1972, Mrs. McCauley lived on Kent Island with her late husband Robert E. She was a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the American Legion Post 278 and the Auxiliary of the VFW 7464. She was also a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church. Mrs. McCauley loved to golf, sew, and was a doll maker. She briefly volunteered for the Estate Treasures Hospice Program.

She is survived by her two daughters, Nancy M. Schrum and her husband John of Pasadena, MD and Jean Marie Holman and her husband Robert of Havre de Grace, MD; sister, Catherine Clark of Abingdon, MD and two brothers, Frank Maggio of Hanover, PA, and her late brother Philip C Maggio. She is also survived by her four grandchildren, Ryan S. Holman, Maria S, Samantha J, and Megan A. Schrum.
