Prudence (Enza) Lombardo of Crownsville, Maryland, formerly of Stevensville and Chestertown, Maryland passed away peacefully, surrounded by family, on Sunday, October 12, 2008 at the Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, Maryland. She was 85.

She was born on April 10, 1923 in Montalbano Elicona, Sicily, Italy; daughter of Gaetana and Gaetano Stefano. After college, she was a school teacher in Sicily where she met her husband, John, a United States Veteran of WWII, married and then moved to his hometown of Penns Grove, NJ. Later Enza and John owned and operated Lombardo's Sub Shop, a family restaurant in Chestertown, Maryland for 32 years. "Mama Enza" loved to cook. She cooked for thousands of customers, friends and family who kept coming back year after year for her delicious Italian dishes and cookies.

She was preceded in death by John in 2004, her husband of 57 years.
