



Quentin Oscar Cupp Sr.

January 20, 1924 - September 28, 2012

Quentin Oscar Cupp, Sr. "Cuppy" of Stevensville, MD, died Friday, September 28, 2012, at 11:00 p.m. at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 88.

Born in Defiance, OH, on January 20, 1924, he was the son of the late, Bulaugh McClelaugh. He was a member of the U.S. Navy from 1941 to 1960 and received numerous awards and medals during World War II and the Korean Conflict. After his retirement Cuppy dedicated much of his time to the American Legion Post 278 in Stevensville, MD, earning the status of a paid up member for life. Cuppy's passion for his family and sports led to many years of enjoyment, rooting for his favorite team the Washington Redskins, surrounded by his loved ones.

Mr. Cupp is survived by seven children, Norrine Eckstein of Manassas, VA, Mary Cupp of Fairfax, VA, Quentin Cupp, Jr. of Riva, MD, William Cupp of Tucson, AZ, Dolores Kanownik of Stevensville, MD, Anita Waters of Centreville, MD, and Patrick Cupp of Greensboro, MD. Mr. Cupp has twenty-two grandchildren and twenty-nine great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his loving wife of forty-two years, Margaret Hunt Cupp.

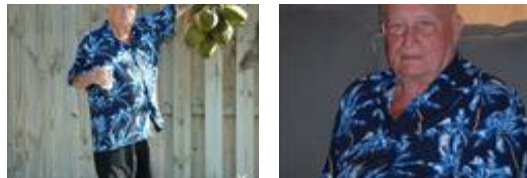

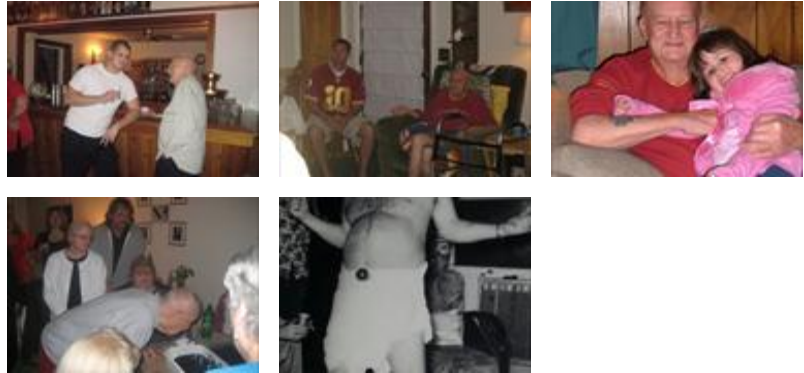
