October 15, 1937 - March 1, 2015

R. Douglas Prothero died on Sunday, March 1, 2015, at Genesis HealthCare-The Pines. He was 77.

Born on October 15, 1937, in Wilmington, DE, he was the son of the late Ray D. and Lillian Aleene Mullins Prothero.

Douglas served in the U.S. Army from 1960-1965. He married the former Wanda Barwick on October 12, 1963, and they lived in Wilmington for forty years until moving to Easton in 2003. Mr. Prothero received his B.S. in Biology at the University of Delaware, where he was a member of the Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity. Douglas previously worked as a pharmaceutical representative and most recently as a maintenance engineer.

Douglas always tried to help and do for others wherever and whenever possible. He loved walking, being with his family, working outside around the house, and doing church work. He was a member of the Bethesda United Methodist Church in Preston.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Wanda; children, Robert David Prothero of Newark, DE, and Stewart Douglas Prothero of Hemet, CA; sisters, Sandy Prothero Spisak of Willow Springs, NC, Bette Prothero McBean of Walworth, NY, and Debbie Prothero Coots of Rushville NY; and one

granddaughter, Jessica Aleene Prothero of Newark, DE.
