



Rachel Hess Weedman

September 8, 1922 - May 22, 2022

Rachel Hess Weedman of Sudlersville, MD, passed away Sunday, May 22, 2022, at Queenstown Landing Assisted Living in Queenstown, MD. She was 99.

Rachel H. Weedman was born Sept. 8, 1922 in Rutledge, MD, the daughter of the late James B. Hess, Sr., and Gurtha “VanZant” Hess. Mrs. Weedman graduated from Jarrettsville High School Class of 1939. She continued her education at Washington College and graduated in 1943. Mrs. Weedman was a teacher/librarian until 1966 at Sudlersville High School. Mrs. Weedman then became the media specialist at Queen Anne’s High School and retired in 1984. She was a member of Calvary-Asbury United Methodist Church in Sudlersville, MD, where she played the organ for over 50 years. In addition to the church, she was a Life Member of VFW Auxiliary Post 652, Frank Jarmon Auxiliary Post 36, the Millington American Legion Auxiliary Post 192, Retired Teachers Association, Red Hat Society, member of Delta Kappa Gama, Red Cross Volunteer, and Sudlersville Planning Commission Board.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Charles N. Weedman, and one brother, James B. Hess, Jr.

She is survived by her daughter, Pat Hovey (Bob) of Kansas City, MO; two grandchildren, Michael Hovey (Mandee) of Atlanta, GA, and Charlie Hovey

(Marie) of Kansas City, MO; two great-grandchildren, Peyton Marie Hovey of Atlanta, GA, and Hannah Rachel Hovey of Atlanta, GA; and one nephew, James B. Hess III (Cindy) of Phoenix, MD.

A visitation will be held Thursday, June 2, 2022, from 11am to 12pm at Calvary-Asbury United Methodist Church in Sudlersville, MD. Services will begin at 12pm. Interment will follow the service in Sudlersville Cemetery.

For me, she was among the most important and influential educators at Sudlersville High School during my time there--in the days when it went from grades 7-12. 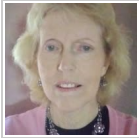
