Ralph S. Cox of Chestertown, Maryland formerly of Rock Hall, Maryland died on October 5, 2008 at his home. He was 90.

Born in Chestertown, Maryland on May 8, 1918, he was the son of the late Samuel Joseph and Marian Joiner Cox.

He was married on May 31, 1938 to Edna Rasin Cox and they lived in Worton where he worked as a farmer until beginning his career as a mechanic. They then moved to Rock Hall where they would reside for the next 60 years.

Mr. Cox worked with General Motors Corporation, Don Kelly Chevrolet in Chestertown, Vita Foods, and finished his career as a mechanic with Kingstown Tractor, retiring in 1981. He was a member of Rock Hall Senior Citizens, and attended Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Rock Hall. He enjoyed playing the guitar, fishing, gardening, camping, and dancing. He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather.

In addition to his wife of 70 years he is survived by a son: Douglas and his wife Carol Cox of Crumpton, MD, a daughter: Susan and her husband Butch Price of Rock Hall, MD, along with nine grandchildren, sixteen great grandchildren, and two great great grandchildren. One son the late Ralph Cox Jr. predeceased him, along with one grandson.
