



Ralph Paul Marsico

October 22, 1945 - December 27, 2020

Ralph Paul Marsico of Stevensville, MD, died on December 27, 2020, at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. He was 75.

Born on October 22, 1945, in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Salvatore Ferrarello and Rose Spennato. Ralph grew up in Springfield, PA, and graduated from St. James High School in Chester, PA. He attended Marshall University in WV and graduated from St. Joseph's University in Philadelphia, PA, with a Bachelor's degree. He spent most of his career as an accountant in the advertising industry. Shortly after retiring, Ralph moved to the Eastern Shore and settled in Stevensville, MD. He enjoyed fishing and Eastern Shore living. He also loved spending time with his family and vacationing with friends -- especially in the Caribbean Island of Antigua.

He is survived by his son, Stephen M. Marsico (Christa) of Eldersburg, MD; and two grandsons, Anthony Marsico and Dominic Marsico. His beloved wife, Joan Marie Gillespie, died just days after his passing on December 29, 2020.

A private prayer service for both Ralph and his wife, Joan Gillespie, will be held 1PM, Friday, January 8, 2021, at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD 21619 and will be live-streamed on the funeral home website. A graveside committal will immediately follow in the Stevensville Cemetery. A celebration of Ralph's life

will be held at a later date when the civil mandated restrictions are lifted.
