



Ralph A. Reskovitz III

April 30, 1958 - July 15, 2014

Ralph Aloysious Reskovitz III of Chestertown, MD, died on July 15, 2014, at his home in Tolchester. He was 56.

Born in Wilmington, DE, on April 30, 1958, he was the son of the late Francis J. Reskovitz and Sarah Virginia Hart Simpler. Ralph was educated in Kent County and enlisted in the U.S. Army National Guard serving six years stateside, four years active duty, and two years as a reservist. He was honorably discharged in 1982.

He returned to Kent County and worked with Dixon Valve and Coupling Company and also with KRM both in Chestertown.

In response to his love of the outdoors, he began a career as an Arborist, working with Asplund Tree Company, Davie Tree, Bob Pardoe with Pardoe's, and Anthony Tree Service. His career as an arborist spanned 25 years.

Ralph later worked with Huff Corporation in Potomac as a supervisor until their consolidation. He then finished his career with PEI Electronics in Millington. He was a member of St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall, MD. Ralph enjoyed Bass Fishing and flying radio controlled planes. He loved playing his guitars, working on antique tractors, and caring for his cats and dog.

He is survived by his brother, Stephen Reskovitz and his family of Tolchester, MD; his aunt, Ellen Brady of Tolchester, MD; and cousins, Peter VanVeen, David VanVeen and Carol VanVeen.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Friday, July 25, 2014, at 10 a.m. at St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall, MD. Relatives and friends may call on Thursday, July 24, 2014, from 6 p.m. – 8 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chestertown, MD. Interment will be in St. John's Cemetery.
