



Ralph G. "Pat" Watson Jr.

November 9, 1919 - March 28, 2013

Ralph George "Pat" Watson, Jr., of Chestertown, MD, died on Thursday, March 28, 2013. He was 93.

Mr. Watson was born on November 9, 1919, in Chesapeake City, MD. He was the son of the late Ralph George Watson, Sr., and Nettie Blunt Watson. Mr. Watson worked with Local 25 Operating Engineers as an operator and superintendent from 1947 until he retired in 1986. While working with Local 25, he traveled to many different places such as Africa, South America, and Puerto Rico. Mr. Watson served in the United States Army during World War II. He was married for 56 years to Betty Jean Watson. She predeceased him in 2003.

Mr. Watson was a member of the V.F.W. in Chesapeake City, MD, and the American Legion. He enjoyed crabbing, fishing, and was an accomplished woodworker who enjoyed carving waterfowl and building Chesapeake Bay workboats.

He is survived by two sons, Pat Watson, III, of Dover, DE, and Mike Watson of Townsend, DE; a daughter, Shawyn Watson of Chestertown, MD; a brother, Charles "Brooke" Watson of Elkton, MD; nine grandchildren; and eleven great-grandchildren.
