



## Ralph Morgan Groff

Ralph M. Groff of Chester died on Tuesday, February 12, 2002 at his home. He was 74.

Born on February 6, 1928 in Berlin, PA, he was the son of the late Ralph A. and Euclid Bender Groff. He graduated from Berlin High School in PA, and then served in the U.S. Army during WWII. Mr. Groff then attended Caterman's Business College in Cumberland, and would later serve as a police officer with the D.C. Police Department. Upon his retirement from the police force in 1979, he became treasurer for the Kennedy Center in D.C. Mr. Groff resided in the New Carrollton Metropolitan area until his retirement from the Kennedy Center in 1994. He then moved to Chester, where he was an officer with the Kent Island Senior Center, past Vice President of the Bridgepointe Association, and a very active member of Galilee Lutheran Church, where he was Vice President of the congregation. Mr. Groff was also President of the Kennedy Center Local Union, a member of the Army band, and a member of the Elks Lodge.

Mr. Groff is survived by his wife of 50 years, the former Ruth A. Flick; eight children; a sister, Audrey Harkcom of Berlin, PA, fourteen grandchildren; five daughters-in-law and two sons-in-law. He was predeceased by a daughter, Lynn A. Groff in 1951.

A memorial service will be held 11:00AM on Friday, February 15, 2002 at Galilee Lutheran Church, Chester.
