



## Ralph Wallen McGinnes

Ralph Wallen McGinnes of Chestertown, Md. died on March 24, 2001 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was 85.

Born in McGinnes Corner, Queen Anne's County Maryland on May 25, 1915, he was the son of the late Harry Franklin and Bertha Myrtle Wallen McGinnes.

Mr. McGinnes was a 1932 graduate of Sudlersville High School; soon after his graduation he began work with his father as a farmer. Mr. McGinnes continued his career as a farmer and in 1962 owned and operated his own farm until his retirement.

He was married in 1946 to Amanda Lee Coursey, they lived in Church Hill, Md. and in 1965 moved to Deep Landing. Mr. McGinnes retired from farming in 1980. On October 15, 1999 his wife predeceased him.

He was a member of Chestertown Baptist Church for over 20 years volunteering many hours. He enjoyed refinishing furniture and gardening.

He is survived by a son: Mac McGinnes of Church Hill, Md., two sisters: Elsie R. Trojak of Palo Alto, Calif. and Helen E.
