Ramón Rojas of Cordova, MD, formerly of Glen Burnie, died on Thursday, September 7, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 77 years old.

Born February 28, 1929 in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He was the son of the late Pedro Rojas Díaz and Elisa Márquez Rojas. He was a member of the U.S. Air Force for twenty one years, having served in Korea and Vietnam. Mr. Rojas was the personal flight engineer for Vice President Hubert Humphrey on Air Force II, and was privileged to fly on Air Force I under Presidents, John F. Kennedy and Lyndon Johnson. He met and knew many senators and congressmen, and foreign dignitaries and traveled all over the world. After retiring from the U.S. Air Force, her served as Manager and Maintenance Engineer for Navieras de Puerto Rico, a shipping company in Baltimore, MD and later took a position as Facilities Engineer/Supervisor for the Prince George's County Landfill.

Mr. Rojas is survived by his wife, the former Carolyn Jean Shirley, whom he married in 1972; two brothers, Pedro Rojas of Garden City, NY and Juan Rojas of Bayamón, Puerto Rico; and four sisters, Margarita Torres of Río Piedras, Puerto Rico, Flora Molinary and Carmen Figueroa of Bayamón, Puerto Rico, and Lucy Rojas of Florida. He was predeceased by three brothers, Antonio Rojas, Luis Rojas and Manuel Rojas; and a sister, María Almística.

A Funeral Liturgy for Mr. Rojas will be celebrated on Wednesday, September 13, 2006 at 10:00 AM at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, in Cordova, MD.
