



## Randolph Jacquette

Randolph "Tink" Bird Jacquette of Rock Hall, MD, died on Tuesday, September 14, 2004, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 88.

Born in Broadneck in Kent County, MD, on May 25, 1916, he was the son of the late, James LeRoy and Irene Emma Metcalf Jacquette. He was drafted into the United States Army in 1941 and served in World War II in the European Theatre and was honorably discharged in 1945. He then took a position with the United States Postal Service as an automotive mechanic, where he worked for 20 years.

He married Bertha Doretta Dowling of Rock Hall in 1977, and she predeceased him on March 2, 2003.

He was a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church.

He is survived by a brother, Curtis Jacquette of Rock Hall, along with several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, September 19, 2004, at 2:00 PM at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Rock Hall.
