Randolph Lee Dunham of Easton, MD, died on Saturday, April 21, 2007, at Talbot Hospice House. He was 77.

Born in Washington, DC, September 24, 1929, he was the son of the late Homer Durston and Ada Phinney Dunham. He moved to Easton in July 1941 after residing in Connecticut and Virginia. After graduating from Easton High School in 1947, he attended the University of Richmond where he graduated in 1953 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Business Administration. He then served in the U.S. Army from 1953 until 1955, the last year of which he was stationed in Korea. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Easton where he worked for Arthur Southard, CPA in public accounting. From 1960 to 1991, he worked as the Controller for the Talbot County Public Schools. He came out of retirement in 1993 to serve for one year as the Controller for the Caroline County Public Schools.

Active in the community, he was a member of Christ Church where he had served on the Vestry. He had served as President and Treasurer of Dixon House, was Past Treasurer of Channel Marker, the Neighborhood Service Center and the Londonderry Retirement Center and was active with the Auxiliary of Memorial Hospital. He was also Past Treasurer of the Talbot County Mental Health Association and had served with the State Mental Health Association. Professionally, he was a member and Past Treasurer of

the Talbot County Teacher's Association, a member of the Maryland State Teacher's Association, and a member of the Business Officials of Maryland and Washington, DC.

Mr. Dunham is survived by his brother, Harvey D. Dunham of FL; several nieces and nephews; and one special nephew, Donald R. Cole, III.

A memorial service will be held at a later date.
