



Ray Eugene Faulkner

December 2, 1934 - August 9, 2026

Ray Eugene Faulkner, affectionately known as “Pip” of Easton, passed away on Sunday, August 9, at the Talbot Hospice House after a short stay following a long illness. Pip was 91 years old, born on December 2, 1934, in Talbot County.

Pip served in the United States Army from November 1954-1956 and was stationed in Schofield Barracks, Central O’ahu, Hawaii, where he attained the rank of Corporal.

After his Army discharge, Pip married Ann Wolcott in 1958. He then began his career as an Electrician, first working for Forney Electric and then for Waverly Press before his retirement. A life member of American Legion, and the VFW Auxiliary of E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 in Easton where he had his own “self-assigned” bar stool. Pip was known for his quick wit and bantering with his friends there, but was always loved for his gentle and kind nature. Pip and Ann enjoyed a month in Ocean City every summer where they hosted many friends and created many memories. Those stories were embellished for years. He was an avid Yankees fan and his most prized possessions were his Corvettes, and then his Black 2002 Cadillac Eldorado, that he proudly sported around town until his latest illness.

Pip is survived by several nieces, nephews and many friends. He was blessed

with special neighbors, Linda and Howard Townsend, who watched out for him, shoveled his snow, brought over food and engaged Pip in many conversations this past year. The Talbot Hospice Staff are so appreciated for their support, special compassion and extraordinary care that Pip and his family received during his last six months of life.

He is preceded in death by his wife of 45 years, Ann W Faulkner who passed in 2003, as well as several half/step siblings, nieces, nephews and numerous lifelong friends. Pip held a special place in his heart and spent cherished time over the past several years with his sweet Grace Cooper, until her recent death in December, 2025

A Graveside Service and Burial will be held at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD, 1:30 pm, on Thursday, August 13.
