



Raymond Albert Boyles

March 24, 1943 - November 13, 2022

Raymond Albert Boyles of Sudlersville, MD, passed away on Sunday, November 13, 2022, at the Resorts at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. He was 79.

Born March 24, 1943, in Sudlersville, he was the son of the late Albert Boyles and Dorothy Jeanette “Stafford” Boyles. He left school before graduating to go work at Leed’s Travelware where he worked for 15 years before marrying his wife, Hazel Boyles, in 1961.

Ray then went to work for Johnson Controls and eventually began working for Reynolds and Reynolds where he retired after 20 years. After retirement he took a job at Walmart and worked for six more years before fully retiring. He enjoyed gardening, mowing his grass, taking care of his cars, watching Judge Judy and dancing.
