



Raymond Earl Hill

On November 29, 1999, Raymond Earl Hill of Fort Ave. in Baltimore, MD, died at the Meridian Nursing Center- Corsica Hill in Centreville, MD, after a long illness. He was 91 years old.

He was born in Baltimore on June 17, 1908, the son of the late William Hurst Hill and the late E. Louise Klein Hill. He attended school in south Baltimore. On Aug. 20, 1927, he married Hattie Louise Lanehart of Baltimore. She predeceased him March 13, 1957. Mr. Hill worked as a truck driver for Westvaco Paper Co. for over 40 years. He retired in 1969. He was a member of Teamsters Union.

He is survived by Dorothy Louise Stevens of Chester MD; one sister, Evelyn Foster of Pasadena, MD; two grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by his son, Raymond E. Hill, Jr., (died Nov. 29, 1986) and two brothers, James Preston and William Hurst Hill.
