



Raymond George Ferguson

December 31, 1939 - April 19, 2023

Raymond George Ferguson of Baltimore, MD, passed away on April 19, 2023, at Union Memorial Hospital. He was 83 years old.

Ray was born in Baltimore, on December 31, 1939, the son of the late Earl B. and Mary Catherine Ferguson. He was a graduate of the Baltimore Polytechnic Institute with the Class of 1957, where he lettered in both lacrosse and ice hockey. He graduated with his bachelor's degree from the University of Maryland and the University of Baltimore. On January 27, 1963, he married Jan Glowa Ferguson.

During his professional career, Ray worked in sales and as the Manager of National Accounts for VWR Scientific.

Ray was an avid traveler, visiting all seven continents and half of the countries in the world. He loved coaching lacrosse, especially beginners and young players. He had fond memories of his annual fishing trips to Alaska with friends. He enjoyed spending his summers in Ocean City with his grandchildren, also the place where he met his wife in the summer of 1958. He was a member of the Maryland Club, and the Buttons Creek Hunting Club in Dorchester County.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, Dr. McGregor

Ferguson.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Jan Ferguson; his son, Dr. Andrew Ferguson (Karen); and five grandchildren, Cole, Reed, Grace, Claire, and Alexander.

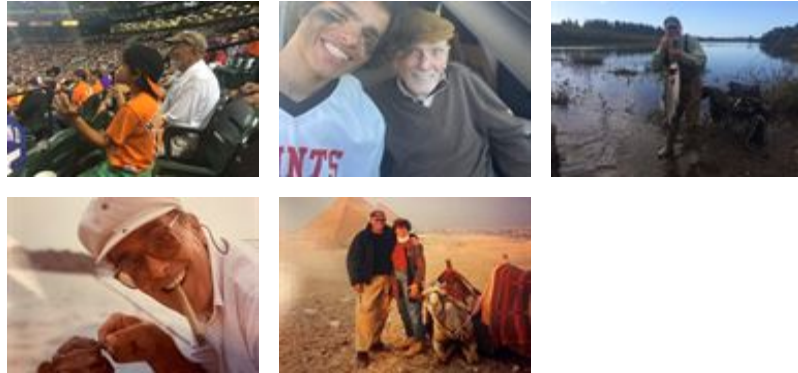
