Raymond James Foreman of Dundalk, Md. died on Sunday, April 27, 2003 in his home, a victim of a brutal homicide. He was 85.

Born in Rock Hall, Md. he was the son of the late Raymond B. and Reba Downey Foreman and husband of the late Frances Vansant who died in 1976 and the late Hilda Foreman who died in 1995. Mr. Foreman attended school in Rock Hall, Md. and at a young age went to work for Martin Marietta as a painter. He worked in this company for nearly 40 years while also providing for his family through commercial painting and harvesting crabs and fish. He retired in 1977 and holding a commercial crabbing and fishing license he continued to enjoy both his past time and his occupation as a commercial waterman, while living in Dundalk, Md. He was a member of the Maryland Waterman's Association. He is survived by two daughters; Rosalie Forman and Cindy Hanna-Hyland, two stepsons; Jack Garrett and Robert Garrett, a stepdaughter; Selena Zook, along with numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.
