Raymond Allen Marshall (Butch Marshall) of Greensboro, MD, died on February 9, 2015, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 62.

Born on August 10, 1952, in Washington DC, to the late Alan and Carol Marshall, he grew up Annapolis, MD. He graduated from Annapolis High School and worked for Bert Spriggs Lincoln and Mercury and earned a Bachelor's degree in electronics. He then finished out his career for Arch Wireless until 2004.

Butch enjoyed classic cars, wood working, refurbishing his 1959 Chevy Pick-up, and especially spending time with his grandchildren riding on his tractor. He was a member of the Knights of Pythian and amateur ham radio operators club.
