



Raymond "Ray" Gene Cullison Jr.

Raymond "Ray" Gene Cullison, Jr. passed away on August 3, 2025 at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. He was 58 years old. Ray was born Annapolis, MD on October 9, 1966, the son of the late Raymond Gene Cullison, Sr. and Bertie Benton Cullison. He graduated from Queen Anne's County High School with the class of 1984. After high school, he became a member of the Kent Island Volunteer Fire Department, earning the rank of Sergeant. During his time at the Fire Department, he found his career as a paramedic after witnessing and assisting with an accident that showed him his true calling. He became a paramedic with the Anne Arundel County Fire Department, where he met his wife, Tricia, who was working at a local hospital at the time. The two were married in October of 1998 and had their beloved son, John, in 1999.

In 2001, Ray suffered an injury that unfortunately forced him to retire. His department was his second family, and he was known as being a complete goofball. He was always pulling pranks and trying to make his coworkers laugh, then would swiftly switch into a dedicated and focused paramedic when duty was called. His prankster antics were not limited to just the fire department – if you knew and loved Ray, you knew to always be on the lookout for the next joke or trick.

In his free time, Ray enjoyed ghost hunting and going on ghost tours, often accompanied by his beloved dog Pugsley, who went everywhere with him. He also enjoyed playing video games with his son, as well as cooking and trying

out new dinner recipes. Although he had no affiliation with a specific church, Ray had a strong personal relationship with God that was very dear to him. In addition to his wife of 27 years, Tricia Cullison, Ray is survived by his son, John Cullison, and brother, Bill Cornell, as well as Pugsley the dog. At Ray's request, no formal services will be held.
