October 26, 1928 - November 16, 2022

Raymond L. Henderson, a retired Research Analyst with the National Security Agency's Operations Organization, died on November 16, 2022. He was 94 years old.

Raymond was born in Brooklyn, NY, and served in the United States Army Security Agency during the Korean conflict. After his tour in the military, in 1952, he joined the National Security Agency and served various positions from Analyst to Division Chief. He retired in 1986 after 38 years of federal service.

Raymond married his wife Dolores in 1952; and they had two sons, Kevin Michael and Brian David. The couple had just celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary on October 25, 2022.

The Stevensville resident enjoyed sports and sailing and was a master at woodworking where he dedicated years of hard work for Ruark Boatworks doing Skipjack renovations in Cambridge, MD.

He is preceded in death by his parents, John and Florence Henderson, and his beloved son, Brian. He is survived by his wife, Dolores; his son, Kevin; his daughter-in-law, Jennifer; four step-grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; and his brother, Richie and sister-in-law, Margie; as well as his nieces and

nephews.
