Raymond Paul Scherl of Chester, MD, passed away May 16, 2018, at home surrounded by his family.

Born in Washington, DC, on September 10, 1939, he was the son of the late Adam Paul Scherl and Frances Hines. Ray was a graduate of DeMatha Catholic High School ('57) and Southeastern University.

He was a career Fire Fighter with the District of Columbia Fire Department, retiring in 1980. He had a varied career since retiring; owned numerous businesses; always doing and reinventing himself. He loved spending time with family and friends, fishing, hunting, boating and woodworking.
