Raymond John Williams, Jr. of Centreville, MD died at his home on Thursday, December 11, 2008. He was 63 years old.

Born on January 13, 1945 in Annapolis, MD to Marie Hemmes Williams and the late Raymond John Williams, Sr. Mr. Williams grew up in Mt. Vernon, OH. When he was 15, his family moved to Cape St. Claire. He attended Severna Park High School and worked as a mason for several years before enlisting in the U.S. Navy. After being honorably discharged, he worked for the United States Naval Academy for 25 years, retiring in 2003. He enjoyed fishing and hunting for deer and quail. He collected coins, S-scale and American Flyer model trains. He restored a 1965 Comet and played both fast and slow pitch softball.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by his loving wife, Hannah Williams of Centreville; three sons, Raymond John Williams, III and his wife, Debbie, of Ingleside, Timothy Allen Williams and his wife, Mindy, of Denton and Christopher Lee Williams, and his wife, Dana, also of Denton; nine grandchildren, Jake and Megan of Ingleside, Ashley and Kellie, Lauren, Luke, Seth, Danielle, and Jack, all of Denton; two brothers, Terry and Eddie Williams both of Cape St. Claire; one nephew and three nieces.
