Raymond Rulon Mears of Centreville, MD died Genesis Eldercare, The Pines, Easton, MD on Thursday, March 25, 2004. He was 89.

Born October 7, 1914 in Centreville, MD, he was the son of the late John Edward and Winnie Dutton Mears. He was a graduate of Centreville High School in 1931. At the age of 16 he worked for the family barber shop, Mears Barber Shop in Centreville. On August 9, 1937 he married the former Margaret Towers of Denton, MD. He served in the U. S. Navy during World War II. He sold the barber shop in 1971 and continued to be a Master Barber well into his 80's.
