



R. Dennis Osterman

February 19, 1947 - June 28, 2009

Roy Dennis Osterman of St. Michaels, MD, formerly of Bethesda, MD, passed away from complications from cancer on June 28, 2009 at age 62. Mr. Osterman, a Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania native, practiced law for more than 30 years and at his death was General Counsel of the Methodist Home of D.C. and served on several boards of civic organizations in St. Michaels and Easton, Maryland.

Over his career, he served as an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the District of Columbia, as trial counsel for Union Pacific Railroad in Omaha, NE and as a Senior Partner and Managing Partner at Lerch, Early and Brewer in Bethesda, MD. During Iran Contra, he represented then President George H.W. Bush. He also taught as adjunct legal faculty member at Creighton Law School and American University. Mr. Osterman graduated from Grove City College and received a Master's Degree and Law Degree from American University in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Osterman is predeceased by his father, Roy Victor Osterman; his mother, Gene Osterman and his sister, Wendie Redeker.

He is survived by a son, Roy Todd Osterman of Baltimore, MD; a daughter, Jessica Lange Osterman, M.D. of South Pasadena, CA; and his wife of 32 years, Andrea Lange Osterman of St. Michaels.
