



## Rebecca Mildred Nickerson

May 25, 1948 - May 7, 2015

Rebecca Mildred Nickerson of Chesapeake City, MD, died Thursday, May 7, 2015, at Union Hospital in Elkton, MD, surrounded by her family. She was 66.

Rebecca M. Nickerson was born May 25, 1948, in Elkton, MD, the daughter of the late Phillip Davis and Isabelle “Cahall” Davis. Mrs. Nickerson was a 1966 graduate of Bohemia Manor High School. In 1972, she married her dedicated and faithful husband, Baynard Nickerson, and the two moved to Chesapeake City to settle their roots. Mrs. Nickerson owned and operated Nickerson Produce Market from 1972-1994. She then started Nickerson’s Meats and operated the business until her passing.

Known to many as the “Cookie Lady” in Cow Town, she loved to do crafts, scrapbooking, cooking large family dinners, and spending time with her grandchildren. In 1986, she was paralyzed due to a microscopic tumor in her back. Regardless of being confined to a wheelchair, she never stopped and she adapted to everyday activities and work with no problems. Mrs. Nickerson was a member of Town Point United Methodist Church in Chesapeake City, MD.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Phillip Davis Jr. and one sister, Eleanor Smith.

She is survived by her husband of 42 years, Baynard Nickerson of Chesapeake City, MD; three daughters, April Lentz and husband Mark of Smyrna, DE, Crystal L. Nickerson of Alexandria, VA, Kelli Eatburn and husband Dan of New Castle, DE; stepson, Wayne Nickerson and wife Mary of Earlville, MD; one brother, Larry Davis of Baltimore, MD; and six grandchildren, Sheena Veasey, Brianna Peterson, Taylor Nickerson, Shanon Capanna, Marianna Eastburn, and Emily Eastburn.

Services will be held Monday, May 11, 2015, at 12 p.m. at Town Point United Methodist Church in Chesapeake City, MD. A visitation will be held one hour prior.

Interment will follow the service in Bethel Cemetery in Chesapeake City, MD.

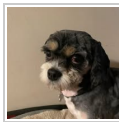
